

# My Region Poster Due Thursday



Our class has been studying the regions of California and the regional attributes of Shasta County. Your child was assigned the project of creating a poster that describes our local region. Students may collect pictures from local magazines, newspapers, and relevant pictures from the Internet that remind them of the human and geographic characteristics of our region: Shasta County.

Students are to illustrate two or three important facts and statistics. Their illustrations might include faces of people that represent populations that live in Shasta County and what they do there, such as work or play, or a drawing that shows how one of the local dams created lakes.

Each poster should include a title and a sentence that explains how they feel about their region. Students may write these by hand or print them on the computer and cut and paste them on their posters. All posters must be done on a large piece of poster board.

Please ask students to refer to their Cornell Notes to remind them of the manmade characteristics and geographical characteristics of Shasta County.

Students will share their projects/posters with the class and describe why they made their selections. **The posters are due January 7<sup>th</sup>.**
