



PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Bella Vista Families,

As September draws to an end, we begin our 8th week of school! A lot has been happening around the school. Students have been busy with after school activities that include flag football, volleyball, and cross-country. Middle School parents have received their students' first progress report. The Parent Club has been busy planning the Halloween Carnival.

The teachers have been busy teaching and setting up interventions to support your students' learning needs. Our classified staff is working hard to insure your children are supervised and safe, well fed with appealing and nutritious food, and transported timely and safely to and from school.

We are excited about our intervention support system that is in place for this year. Our school-wide schedule provides common instructional time for teachers to work together, for small group instruction to occur in and outside of the classroom, and it specifies CORE instructional time for English-Language Arts and Math. The Early Release Days are key to the success of this program, as it requires extensive communication among the staff.

I want to remind you that there is not any supervision on campus until 7:30 a.m. Please do not have your children arrive at school before this time. We want to insure they are safe and supervised. After-school it is mandatory that all students go home or they must be enrolled in Project Share to be on campus. If students want to attend sporting events or are on a sports team and the game is not immediately after school, they must go home and return at the time of the activity. Supervision is not available for students who are "just hanging out". These are rules in the Education Code that schools are mandated to follow.

One of the District goals this year is increased communication. One way we are supporting this goal is in the use of student planners. All classes, 1st – 8th grade, have

planners. Your child is expected to write their assignments in the planner every day. If you have not seen the planner, please ask your child about it. It can be a very effective communication tool between home and school. Our planners are "SPARK" based, tied to our PE curriculum. We are also doing more communication through e-mail. If your e-mail address changes, please notify us right away so we can update our records.
