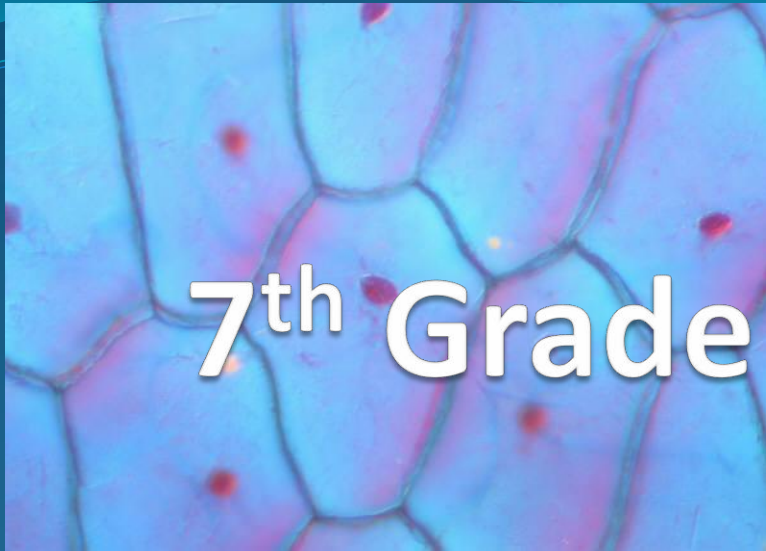


We may discuss things in class that do not seem to be History-related. This is usually done to tie in historical events or concepts to modern times. *Other times it may be done to keep your child awake.*

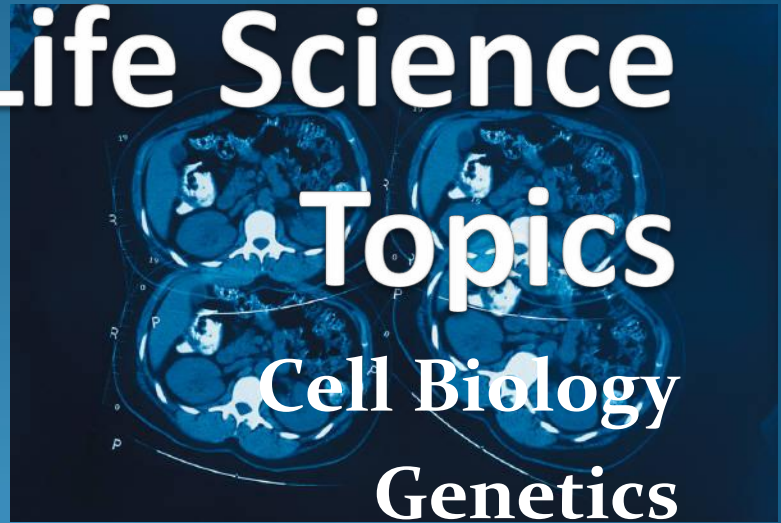

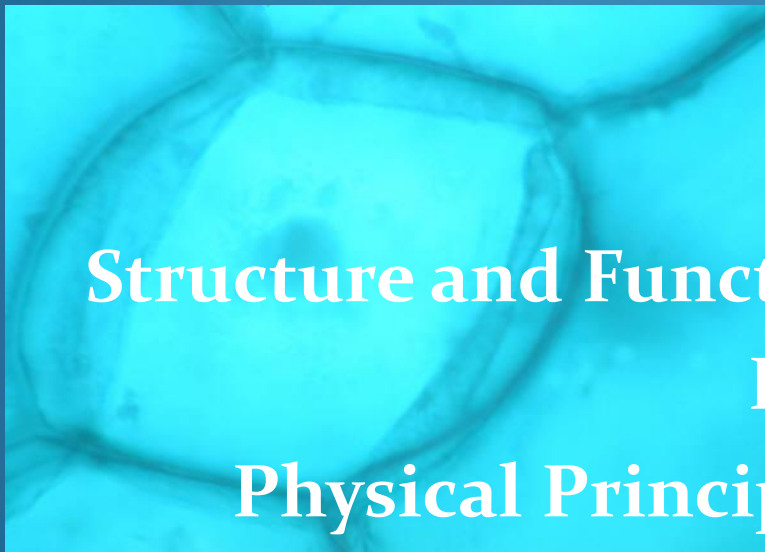

Each student will be given a “Reading Essentials” workbook and a Science Notebook. To keep backpacks lighter, text books will be kept in the classroom, but they may be checked out as needed for homework or make-up work. I also have a limited number of science books on CD ROM that can be checked out.

Each student will need to have a tabbed section in their binder for science only.

Students are expected to come to class prepared, bringing all required materials such as workbooks and pencils. (When purchasing pencils, plan on your student using at least one per day.)

Approximately once per quarter, students will be assigned a project that will need to be completed **outside of class**.

Students who use lab time or equipment inappropriately will be assigned an alternative assignment during the next lab or labs, depending on the severity of the offense.

Your student's grade will be based on his/her participation in class, completion of class work (including labs), projects and homework, and achievement on quizzes and tests.
